Doctrine — Guerrilla Marketing Playbook

The Philosophy

We have zero marketing budget and a product that demos itself. Every document Doctrine generates is potential viral content. Our job: generate provocative responses, excerpt the best parts, and put them where people will share them.

Rule #1: The output IS the marketing. **Rule #2:** Controversy drives clicks. Perspectives drive shares. **Rule #3:** Free first run. Always. No friction.

Week 1-4 Launch Sequence

Week 1: "The Reveal" (Soft Launch)

Monday — The Thread - Twitter/X: "I built an AI that writes coherent 24-chapter books. Here's the thing no other AI writing tool has solved..." (10-tweet thread explaining the Bible methodology) - Include: side-by-side screenshots of ChatGPT chapter 20 vs. Doctrine chapter 20 - CTA: "Want to try it? First run is free → doctrine.ai"

Tuesday — The Demo - Post 60-second screen recording: upload document → one click → come back to finished book - Reddit r/artificial: "I built an automated pipeline that writes coherent long-form documents. Here's how it works."

Wednesday — The Response - First "Doctrine Responds" post: "We fed the US Constitution to Doctrine and asked it to respond as a military strategist in 2026. Chapter 3 is... something." - Post the best 500-word excerpt as a thread

Thursday — Technical Deep Dive - Reddit r/MachineLearning: Technical post on Bible methodology. Frame as research contribution, not product. - Hacker News: "Show HN: An AI writing pipeline that maintains coherence across 24+ chapters"

Friday — The Hook - "Doctrine Responds to the Art of War as an AI Superintelligence" — excerpt the most provocative chapter - This becomes the signature content piece for Week 1

Weekend - Engage with every comment, reply, DM - DM 20 AI/writing micro-influencers with a free Pro account offer - Compile analytics, identify what resonated

Week 2: "The God Perspective" (Viral Play)

Monday - Tease: "Tomorrow we're releasing something that might break the internet. We asked AI to write a 20-chapter response to the Bible. From God's perspective. In 2026."

Tuesday — The Drop - Release Chapter 1 excerpt (the most compelling 800 words) - Thread format with dramatic presentation - End with: "19 more chapters. Full document free on Doctrine."

Wednesday-Friday - Release one chapter excerpt per day (Chapters 5, 11, 17 — the most provocative) - Each excerpt ends with link to full document - Cross-post to r/philosophy, r/artificial, r/religion (with appropriate framing)

Weekend - Compile reactions, screenshots of engagement - "This week, 50,000 people read God's AI-generated response to His own book. Here's what we learned."

Week 3: "The Challenge" (User Generation)

Monday — Launch the Challenge - "The Doctrine Response Challenge: Upload ANY document. Pick ANY perspective. Share your best chapter. Tag #DoctrineResponds" - Rules: Use your free first run. Screenshot your best excerpt. Share it. - Prize: Top 5 most-shared responses get free Pro accounts for a year

Tuesday-Thursday - RT and engage with every challenge submission - Highlight the most creative/provocative ones - Create a "Top Responses" thread daily

Friday — Product Hunt Launch - Go live at 12:01 AM PT - Activate all 30+ early supporters - 5 maker comments throughout the day - Offer: "PH exclusive — 3 free Opus runs for the first 100 signups"

Weekend - Monitor PH performance - Engage with all PH comments - Share PH results on Twitter ("We hit #X on Product Hunt!")

Week 4: "The Authority" (Credibility)

Monday - "The AI Writing Coherence Report" — publish a blog post/thread comparing output quality across Doctrine, Sudowrite, NovelCrafter, ChatGPT, and Claude - Objective tone. Let the results speak. - Include specific examples of coherence failures in competitors

Tuesday - Launch academic outreach: email 50 professors with personalized Doctrine responses to their published papers - "We used Doctrine to generate a 15-chapter analysis of your paper on [X] from a [contrarian perspective]. Thought you might find it interesting."

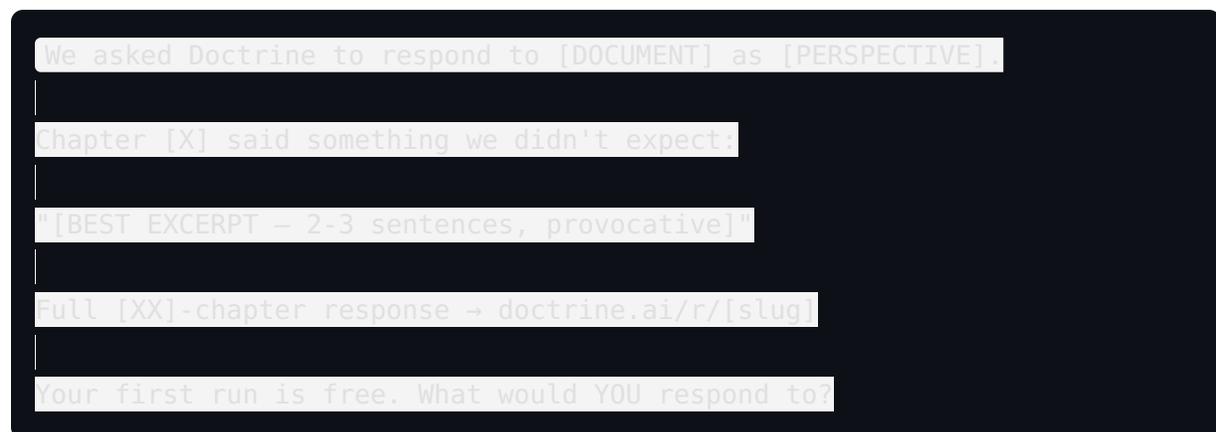
Wednesday - First think tank outreach: generate responses to 5 recent policy papers from Brookings, RAND, Heritage - Email to research directors with sample output

Thursday - "Month 1 by the numbers" thread: signups, documents generated, most popular perspectives, best excerpts - Transparency builds trust and engagement

Friday - Announce referral program: "Give a Run, Get a Run" - Every user gets a referral link. Share it, both parties get a free run.

Reddit Posting Strategy

Rules of Engagement

1. **Never post-and-run.** Engage in the community for 2 weeks before first promotional post.
2. **Lead with value.** The post should be interesting even if they never visit Doctrine.
3. **One promotional post per subreddit per 30 days.** Max.
4. **Always disclose.** "I built this" — transparency builds trust on Reddit.
5. **Have thick skin.** Reddit will roast you. Engage with critics respectfully.

Subreddit Playbook

r/artificial (1.2M members) - Post type: Technical showcase - Title: "I built an AI writing pipeline that maintains coherence across 24 chapters using auto-generated reference documents [OC]" - Include: Technical explanation, sample output, link to try - Engage: Answer every technical question in detail

r/writing (3.2M members) - Post type: Problem/solution narrative - Title: "After testing every AI writing tool, I built one that actually maintains character consistency. Here's what I learned about why AI writes incoherent novels." - Frame as: Writer who solved a writing problem, not a tech person selling a product - Caution: This sub is skeptical of AI. Lead with the craft, not the tech.

r/MachineLearning (2.8M members) - Post type: Research-style writeup - Title: "[P] Bible Methodology: Maintaining coherence in multi-chapter LLM generation through auto-generated reference documents" - Include: Approach, results, evaluation methodology - This audience respects rigor. No marketing language.

r/geopolitics (850K members) - Post type: Content contribution - Title: "I used AI to generate a 20-chapter analysis of [CURRENT POLICY] from a [PERSPECTIVE]. Here are the most interesting arguments it made." - Frame as: Interesting analysis, not product promotion - Link to Doctrine in comments only if asked

r/selfpublish (250K members) - Post type: Honest comparison - Title: "I tested Sudowrite, NovelCrafter, Squibler, ChatGPT, and my own tool for writing a complete novel. Here are the results." - Include: Honest pros/cons of each, including Doctrine's limitations - Authenticity is everything in this community

10 Specific Viral Content Pieces

1. **"The Constitution Responds to 2026"** - Document: US Constitution - Perspective: The Founding Fathers, collectively, evaluating modern America - Hook: "Would the Founders recognize what they built?" - Target audience: Political Twitter, r/geopolitics, LinkedIn

2. **"God Reviews His Book"** - Document: The Bible (selected books) - Perspective: God in 2026, reflecting on how humanity interpreted His words - Hook: Maximum controversy, maximum engagement - Target audience: Philosophy Twitter, viral general audience

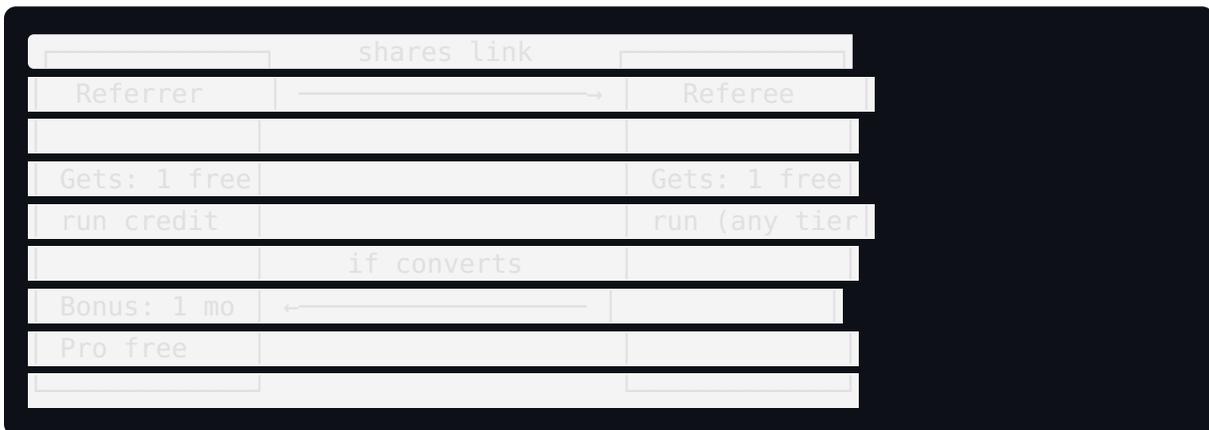

- **Pitch to:** Wired, The Atlantic, Vice
- **Hook:** "An AI Wrote God's 20-Chapter Response to His Own Book. Here's What It Said."
- **Story:** Cultural/philosophical angle on AI capability

Angle 3: "Solo Founder Builds Book-Writing AI in Days"

- **Pitch to:** Indie Hackers, Hacker News, Product Hunt blog
- **Hook:** "How one technical founder built a complete AI writing platform — from zero to production — in days, not years."
- **Story:** Builder/bootstrapper narrative

Angle 4: "Think Tanks Are Using AI to Write Policy Papers"

- **Pitch to:** Politico, Foreign Policy, The Hill
- **Hook:** "A new AI tool lets policy analysts generate comprehensive analysis from multiple geopolitical perspectives. Is this the future of think tank research?"

Conference Playbook

- Before:** Generate Doctrine responses relevant to the conference theme. Print excerpt cards.
- During:** Hand out cards with QR code to free first run. Live demos at booth or in hallways.
- After:** Follow up with every card scan within 48 hours. Personalized Doctrine response to their company/research.

Guerrilla Conference Tactics (No Booth Needed)

- Print 500 business cards with a provocative Doctrine excerpt on the back + QR code
- Host an unofficial side event: "AI Writes Books: Live Demo & Free Drinks"
- Live-tweet Doctrine responses to keynote speakers' talks in real-time
- Leave printed excerpts on chairs in session rooms (check rules first)
